简介

布莱恩·罗切福特 (BRIAN ROCHEFORT) 1985年生于美国罗德岛，现工作居住在洛杉矶。

罗切福特是一位混合媒介雕塑家，主要创作材料是瓷和釉，他创作了许多充满生命力和视觉张力的独特器物，均拥有抽象且迷人的表面纹理。创作过程包括在未经烧制的粘土中加入更多材料，再通过烧制一层又一层的釉面，制作出如火山岩和火山口一样的效果，布满奇妙的色彩和细节特征。作品表面有粗糙不均的块状物和光滑的细小气泡，一切都等待出窑时刻的揭晓。

艺术家作品被众多知名机构收藏，包括：NMAC FOUNDATION，加的斯，西班牙；ZABLUDOWICZ COLLECTION，伦敦，英国；克罗克美术馆，萨克拉门托，美国。布莱恩·罗切福特于2007至2008年在美国蒙大拿州的阿奇·布雷陶瓷艺术基金会 (ARCHIE BRAY FOUNDATION) 获得莉莲奖学金 (LILLIAN FELLOWSHIP)。
